

## COVID-19 Event Visitor Policy

The indoor banquet will follow Princeton University's updated COVID Visitor Policy, which goes into effect Monday, May 16th.

1. Guests can attest to being up-to-date on COVID vaccines as defined by the Visitor Policy.
2. Guests who do not wish to attest to being fully vaccinated must attest\* upon arrival to having received a negative COVID-19 PCR test within 72 hours (or a COVID-19 rapid antigen test within 8 hours) of the start of the visit to campus, OR must wear a face covering at all times during the indoor event and cannot remove it to eat or drink

\*Attestation of a negative COVID test (PCR or rapid) will occur on-site at event check-in.
